

The following excerpt from Resolution 2005-21, which was passed by the Town Council on August 17, 2005, and is given to each candidate or his/her representative upon payment of a political sign bond, should clarify the confusion regarding the placement of political signs within the town.

1. ~~Application completed and required bond submitted in the amount of \$100.00;~~
2. Signs are limited to no larger than three square feet;
3. The placement of signs is prohibited on any public right of way or property owned by the Town;
4. Signs may not be displayed more than thirty (30) days prior to the election and must be removed within seven (7) days after the election;
5. A fine in the amount of \$5.00 for each sign that is picked up by the Town code enforcement for violations of Town regulations. ~~will be subtracted from the bond prior to refund.~~
