Ponce Inlet Fine Art Festival Rules

- This is a fine art show and entries must be original. Standard framed fine art may be created using one medium or a combination of media. Artists may exhibit and be judged on the following: any pure combination of Oil, Acrylic, Watercolor, Pastel, Photography or Drawing. No computer generated crafts or jewelry will be considered for this show. Miniatures may be displayed on a small table or stand a must be 25 sq. inches or less, with mat and frame 63 square inches or less.
- Each artist must enter individually and be present both days of the show from 9am to 5pm or forfeit any awards. No “stand ins” or sharing of booths will be allowed.
- Each artist is responsible for their own sales tax. Tax forms will be provided.
- Space size is approximately 10x10. There is limited space for RV's.
- Space assignments and parking information will be included in the artist packet upon registration. Slides will also be returned at this time.
- Set up is Friday, March 17th from 2pm to 7pm. Please plan for all weather. **The registration table will be located in the boat ramp area.**
- A completed application is a commitment to the show and no refunds will be made. The Ponce Inlet Fine Art Festival, The Daytona Beach News-Journal, the Town of Ponce Inlet, all its sponsors and affiliates are not responsible for damage, loss of artwork, tents or display materials.

Violators of the above rules will be asked to remove their display and will not be eligible for any award.
