COMMENTS

180900068 Carbreak 09/29/18 – Victim reports that she parked her vehicle in off beach parking and found that her purse containing miscellaneous ID and a firearm were missing. The victim’s boyfriend advised that earlier in the day he was unloading the vehicle to go to the beach when he was distracted by an unknown male. He is not sure if the purse was taken during this time frame. As of this time there are no suspects or leads in this case. Case Inactive.

181000002 Carbreak 10/01/2018 – Victim reports that she parked her vehicle in a convenience store parking lot during hard rain storm. She left her purse in the vehicle and as the vehicle was a loaner she did not lock the vehicle properly. When she returned to her vehicle her purse was missing. Surveillance cameras were reviewed and found that a large dark colored SUV had pulled in next to the victims vehicle however no identifying information was developed. It should also be noted that there were several other carbreaks in Ponce Inlet and Daytona Beach Shores during this time frame. Case Continued.

181000003 Carbreak 10/01/2018 – Possibly related to above case. Victim parked her rental vehicle at a local restaurant and dined in that establishment. During this time frame a heavy rainstorm came through the area. When the victim returned to her vehicle the rear window had been broken out and several items removed from the rear of the vehicle. Unable to process for any fingerprints due to bad weather conditions. Case Continued.

181000027 Carbreak 10/16/2018 – Victim parked his vehicle on Lighthouse Drive leaving the windows down a small amount to allow for air to flow. When the victim returned he found that the vehicle had been entered and several items taken. There were no witnesses to the incident and no evidence processed.

181000032 Auto Theft 10/18/2018 – Victim reports that she left her vehicle in the driveway of her residence and went out to dinner with friends. She states that when she returned the vehicle was missing however no key appeared to be missing. Later the victim did report that a key was missing. The vehicle was placed into NCIC/FCIC as stolen. Later that night South Daytona PD found the vehicle parked in a local business on Ridgewood Ave. Attempted to process for evidence however due to moisture no fingerprints were developed. The victim reports that the vehicle was in good condition. Case Continued.

181000049 Carbreak 10/27/2018 – Victim reports that he parked his vehicle in his driveway and left it unlocked during the overnight hours. The victim noticed that one of his neighbors had been burglarized and checked his vehicle. The victim realized that someone had entered his vehicle and taken a firearm from the front console. As of this time there are no serial numbers available on the missing firearm. Canvas of the area for possible video surveillance was negative. Case Continued.

181100016 Burglary 11/13/2018 – Officers responded to a report of a burglary to a business on Front Street. Check of the interior found nothing disturbed and some high dollar equipment in plain view. A cash drawer was missing from a desk and also a bank bag was found empty on a desk. The bank bag was checked for fingerprints with negative results. Possible employee was involved in the incident. Video surveillance from surrounding property was negative. Case Continued.

181100018 Suspicious Death 11/14/2018 – We responded to a suspicious death which was a probable suicide. The victim was found lying in the driveway of his residence. Further investigation found that the subject had a security system that recorded the entire event. After reviewing the surveillance video, the case was judged a suicide. The Medical Examiner concluded the same thing and the case is closed.

181100019 Stolen Vehicle 11/15/2018 – Report of a theft of two motor vehicles from the driveway of a residence. It was found that both vehicles were unlocked, and the keys were in the ignition. Victim stated that one of the vehicles contained a firearm and a Rolex Watch. A check of pawns was negative for the stolen watch and firearm. LPR shows one of the vehicles leaving town at 0257 hrs. The other vehicle was not seen by the LPR's. A check of side streets was negative. The victim had video surveillance that took very detailed photos. Photos of one of the suspects was captured and sent to all agencies in Volusia County and also listed on the Crime stoppers web site. Both vehicles were recovered in Daytona Beach and were in drivable condition Case Continued.

181100020 Carbreak 11/15/2018 – Victim reports that two vehicles were broken into and several items removed. Both vehicles were unlocked and the doors were found wide open by the victim. Case Continued.

181100026 Information 11/16/18 – Victim reported that someone had entered her two vehicles where the keys were left in it and the doors unlocked. At some point during the evening a relative left the garage door open and two vehicles had keys in them and were unsecured. When she went out the next morning she found the keys to the vehicle between the seats. A neighbor turned a checkbook into her that had been located in one of the vehicles. She also found her laptop in the yard. Due to the fact that she did not think anything was missing she decided not to file a police report. An Information report was completed and follow-up only if suspects are identified.

181100034 Carbreak 11/22/18 – Victim came out to his vehicle and found that it had been entered and numerous items were spread all throughout the yard. Only an old wallet was missing. No fingerprints were processable on the vehicle. The victim stated that the vehicle was unlocked.

181100036 Carbreak 11/22/2018 – Victim was informed by his neighbor that his vehicle door was open. Victim stated that when he checked the vehicle the glove compartment had been entered and everything was thrown onto the seat. Several tools were missing. No evidence to be processed. The victim advised that the vehicle had been left unlocked. Case Continued.

181100037 Stolen Vehicle 11/22/2018 – Victim reported that he parked his vehicle in the driveway with the keys left in it. When he came out the next morning the vehicle was missing. Two days later one of the license plates (there are two on the vehicle) was found in Holly Hill. Daytona PD recovered the vehicle 10 days later with stolen plates on it. Numerous items were found inside the vehicle with identification on it. Case Continued.

181100043 Carbreak 11/22/2018 – Victim reported that he left his vehicle unlocked in his driveway during the overnight hours. Someone entered the vehicle and went through all of his personal belongings. No prints or evidence processed. Case Continued.

181100044 Carbreak 11/22/2018 – Victim reported that he left his vehicle unlocked in his driveway during the overnight hours. Someone entered the vehicle and went through all of the items taking a wallet, credit cards and sunglasses. No prints or evidence processed. Case Continued.

181100045 Carbreak 11/22/2018 – Victim reported that he left his vehicle unlocked in his driveway during the overnight hours. When he came out his doors were left open and the vehicle had been fully searched. Nothing was found missing. No prints or evidence processed. Case Continued.

181100046 Stolen Vehicle 11/22/2018 – Victim reports that someone was able to gain entry to his locked garage where he hangs the keys for all of his vehicles. They took two vehicles located both inside the garage and one in the driveway. One of the vehicle was recovered a week later in Sanford Florida. The second vehicle was eventually discovered over two weeks later in the Daytona Beach area. Case Continued.

181100047 Carbreak 11/22/2018 – Victim reported that someone entered his unlocked vehicle while it was parked in the driveway. Nothing taken from the vehicle. Video surveillance found two young B/M's gaining entry to the vehicle. Both appeared to be wearing gloves. Case Continued.

181100048 Carbreak 11/22/2018 – Victim reported that someone entered his unlocked vehicle while it was parked in his driveway. Victim reported nothing missing. No surveillance and no evidence to process. Case Continued.

181100049 Carbreak 11/22/2018 – Victim reports that during overnight hours someone entered his unlocked two vehicles parked in the driveway. One of the vehicles had \$25.00 missing but the other had no items missing. No video surveillance or no evidence processed. Case Continued.

181100050 Carbreak 11/22/2018 – Victim reports that someone entered his unlocked vehicle parked in his driveway. \$50.00 worth of items taken from vehicle. No surveillance and no evidence. Case Continued.

181200013 Theft 12/06/2018 – Victim reported that someone had taken two rings from her bedroom. The only person to have been in the residence was a repairman for the cable/telephone service that she was having problems with. Questioning of the suspect gained an admission for the suspect that he took the rings. One ring had been pawned and arrangements were made to retrieve that ring from the pawn dealer. The Victim's property was recovered and returned. Charges were filed against the suspect. Case closed.

190100021 Carbreak 01/15/2019 – Victim reported that someone rifled through the glovebox of his unlocked vehicle. Nothing was taken. LPR photos were obtained of a suspect vehicle that was later determined to be a stolen car out of Ormond Beach. The vehicle was later recovered in Daytona Beach. Investigators in Ponce Inlet, Ormond Beach and Daytona Beach are attempting to identify the suspects.

*******It should be noted that during the month of November the Town of Ponce Inlet suffered a rash of carbreaks and auto thefts. It should be noted that this is a Countywide problem with all Cities in Volusia County being targeted. Also, the suspects involved in this are targeting unlocked vehicles with keys still in them. Locking of vehicles is the greatest prevention in becoming a victim.*******
